Unicode Gurmukhi fonts



Normal output of number keys: English numbers
“a” key + number key: Gurmukhi numbers

Red keys are “Dead Keys” that require
another key input before an output

“a” key + appropriate vowel key: ਊ, ਊ, ਓ, ਆ, ਐ, ਔ, ਇ, ਈ, ਏ.

“a” key + either of ਸ ਖ ਗ ਜ ਫ ਲ: ਸ਼, ਖ਼, ਗ਼, ਜ਼, ਫ਼, ਲ਼. “a” + “a” or “ ” = ਅ

“a” anyother key = ਅ + key character also “^” + “a” = ਅ
